

#### Describe yourself in three words.

Disciplined. Determined. Focused.

#### Tell us your story in a nutshell.

I'm passionate about using technology to build a better, more sustainable future especially in aviation. Right now, I work as a Service Engineer at ADB Safegate, where I help deploy and maintain Airfield Ground Lighting (AGL) control and monitoring systems. Basically, I work on lighting up runways—quite literally. I've been fortunate to work on projects in places like JKIA in Nairobi, Kandahar in Afghanistan, Doha in Qatar, and now, Melbourne. It's technical work, yes but at its core, it's about making air travel safer and smarter.

## What's one bold move or plot twist that shaped your journey?

Moving to Australia. Hands down.When the job offer came, I could have hesitated. It was a new country, new culture, new everything. But I said yes. And that one decision changed how I see the world—and how I see myself. It wasn't just about geography. It was about embracing uncertainty, betting on myself, and learning to adapt. Looking back, that 'yes' wasn't just a career move it was a personal transformation.

## What moment from your time at KCA University still stands out?

My final year project—it was on an airport baggage handling system. At the time, I thought it was just a school project. Little did I know it was pointing me toward what I'd end up doing professionally.

But the standout moment was during the project presentation. Mr. Griffin Kenga gave me this feedback that was so insightful—it wasn't just about the code or functionality. He pushed me to communicate clearly, to think deeper, to present with clarity. That stuck with me. It changed how I approach challenges to this day.

## What's one big lesson life taught you after graduation?

To keep learning beyond the classroom. No one prepares you for how fast the real world moves. You have to take initiative—to build the habits, mindsets, and skills that help you grow. Degrees open doors, but how you show up afterward determines how far you go.

#### What personal mantra or quote do you live by?

"Stay ready, so you don't have to get ready." It reminds me to always prepare, to be proactive, and to expect opportunity because when it comes, you won't have time to scramble.

## If you could send a one-minute voice note to a current KCA student, what would you say?

"Hey there. You're in a season that's about more than exams, it's about building the foundation for your future. Don't limit yourself to the syllabus. Pick up that new skill. Talk to that mentor. Try that side project. And remember it's okay not to have it all figured out. Just stay curious, stay consistent, and stay connected. Every effort counts. You're closer than you think."

## Any message to your past self or to the alumni community?

To my past self: Keep going. All the little things you're doing now will matter more than you know.

To fellow alumni: Let's reconnect,not just with the university, but with each other. Share your story. Mentor someone. Collaborate. You never know who's listening or who might need the exact path you've walked. Together, we can shape the kind of future we once dreamed about in lecture halls and project rooms.

Joseph's story is a testament to the power of bold choices, technical excellence, and lifelong learning. From campus corridors to global airports, he's showing us that no dream is too distant and no leap too big when you believe in your growth.

#### Describe yourself in three words:

Strategic. Professional. Leader.

#### Tell us your story in a nutshell:

I'm a passionate audit and finance professional with over 15 years of hands-on experience helping organizations thrive through strong financial leadership, smart risk management, and empowered teams.

As a Fellow of ACCA and a proud graduate from KCA University and the University of Essex, I've had the privilege of working across industries—from education and construction to NGOs and global investment firms—making a real impact through integrity, insight, and innovation.

What truly excites me is the power of finance to drive change. I love solving complex problems, building high-performing teams, and creating systems that not only work—but work better. Right now, I'm making that impact as a Senior Auditor at Essex County Council, where I lead risk-based audits, support anti-fraud initiatives, and advise senior leaders on strengthening internal controls.

I'm driven by a deep belief that finance is more than numbers—it's about trust, strategy, and building a better future. I'm here to grow, to lead, and to inspire others to do the same. To raise the standard, challenge the norm, and build something extraordinary.

## What's one bold move or plot twist that shaped your journey?

While pursuing my undergraduate degree at KCA University, I made a bold and life-changing decision—to pair my BCom studies with the ACCA professional qualification. After attending a career day session at the university, I was inspired by the global opportunities that ACCA could unlock. With a dream to work beyond borders, I committed myself fully—attending full-time BCom classes during the day and ACCA classes in the evenings. It wasn't easy. While many of my classmates enjoyed the usual campus life, I was investing long hours, driven by a vision bigger than the moment.

That decision became the turning point of my career. Just a few months after graduation, I joined an audit firm and steadily rose through the ranks—from Audit Assistant to Head of Audit Department. That bold move didn't just shape my career—it opened international doors. It led me to pursue an MBA in the UK and take up my current role as a Senior Auditor at Essex County Council.

## What moment from your time at KCA University still stands out?

One moment that has stayed with me from my time at KCA University is the lasting influence of my lecturer, Mr. Ojwang. He wasn't just a lecturer—he was a mentor who believed in pushing us beyond our limits.

Every lecture began with a few minutes of life advice, motivation, or a reality check. He wasn't afraid to challenge us, and his strictness was legendary—but so was his impact. Mr. Ojwang's tough love lit a fire in me. His words made me reflect deeply on the kind of future I wanted to build.

Instead of shying away, I leaned in—working harder in all his subjects and nurturing a deep passion for accounting and finance. His dedication taught me discipline, resilience, and the value of giving your best every single day. For that, I'm truly grateful.

#### What's one big lesson life taught you after graduation?

If there's one lesson life has taught me since graduation, it's this: learning never stops. The classroom may close its doors, but life opens new ones every single day—and each one is a chance to grow.

I've learned that you don't need to have all the answers; you just need the right attitude—a willingness to learn, adapt, and improve. Whether it's in the workplace, through challenges, or new environments, I've embraced each experience as an opportunity to become better—one step at a time, one day at a time.

Staying curious has been my secret weapon. When we stop learning, we stop growing—and that's where stagnation begins. But when we remain open, hungry for knowledge, and committed to self-improvement, we keep moving forward—not just in our careers, but in our lives.

#### What personal mantra or quote do you live by?

The words I live by are: "One day at a time. Yesterday is gone, and tomorrow may never be mine. No regrets, no procrastination—do it today."

This simple but powerful mantra keeps me grounded and focused. It reminds me to make the most of each day, to act with intention, and to never put off what truly matters. Life is too short to wait for the "perfect moment"—the time to grow, to try, to move forward is now.

## If you could send a one-minute voice note to a current KCA student, what would you say?

If I could send a one-minute voice note to a current student, here's what I'd say: *Dare to dream big*—and put in the work. The extra effort you invest today could open doors you never imagined tomorrow. Your bold move starts now. Never underestimate the power of a mentor or a tough moment. Often, the people who challenge you the most are the ones who believe in your potential.

Embrace the journey—you're being shaped for something greater. Keep learning. Stay curious, stay humble, and remember: your best self is always under construction. Growth doesn't end at graduation.

So take that step. Chase that goal. Ask that question. Progress happens when we stop waiting and start doing—one day at a time.

## What was your nickname or go-to hangout spot on campus?

If I wasn't in a lecture room, you could almost always find me in one of three places:

- 1. The library, buried in books and notes;
- 2. The field along Thika Road, taking a moment to unwind and reflect; or
- 3. The cafeteria, enjoying my all-time favourite combo—a mandazi filled with a smokie!

Those simple moments—whether studying, relaxing, or grabbing a bite—were part of what made campus life memorable. They grounded me, gave me space to recharge, and reminded me that balance is key to success.

## Any message to your past self or to the alumni community?

It's never too early or too late to chase your dreams. The right time doesn't arrive someday in the future it's right now. Today is what we truly have. Tomorrow is never guaranteed.

So don't wait for the stars to align. Start where you are, with what you have. Take that first step—then another. Keep showing up, keep pushing forward, and let your discipline do the work even when motivation fades.

You have everything it takes to build the future you want. And remember: greatness is a journey built one step at a time.

## How would you describe yourself today, in just three words?

Collaborative. Empowering. Connected.

#### Let's start from the heart—what's your story in a nutshell?

I care maybe a little too deeply about the world we live in and the people in it. Especially women. Especially the planet. Especially women on the planet. Right now, I'm the co-founder and CTO of Sanasana Sustainability, a startup that helps logistics companies in Africa track and reduce their carbon emissions while still growing their profits. It's technical work, yes, but it's also deeply personal. I want to help build an Africa where climate action is practical and powerful—and where women, particularly in STEM, are not just included, but leading. Outside the startup world, I try to show up in spaces that promote gender equity in tech. Because if there's one thing I know for sure, it's that when women rise, communities rise too.

## What's one bold decision you made that changed everything?

Quitting my first tech job seven months after graduating. I'd worked there for two years and things were... okay. But I felt boxed in. So I took a leap and joined a one-year entrepreneurship program in Ghana. I was terrified. Who quits a stable job in today's economy? But something inside me said, "There's more." And there was. That year stretched me in ways I never expected. It taught me to trust my instincts, take risks, and think beyond survival—to legacy.

## Is there a moment from your time at KCA University that still stays with you?

So many. But the Chillzone stands out. That space brought us together. We'd talk about everything—assignments, startups, heartbreaks, weekend plans, existential crises (you know, the usual). Some of my closest friendships started there. We didn't know it then, but those conversations were shaping who we'd become. And honestly? I still lean on those people today. They're my tribe.

## What's one lesson you've learned since graduating?

That your network is your net worth. And not just for jobs or LinkedIn opportunities. I'm talking about real connections. The people who send you a message when you go silent for too long. The ones who root for you quietly. The ones who challenge you to be better. Skills matter, sure. But the people you walk with? They shape your journey just as much.

#### A quote or mantra that guides you?

"They are as human as you are." It helps me stay grounded. Reminds me that whether I'm in a boardroom, pitching a product, or just trying to explain carbon emissions to a reluctant stakeholder everyone's just human. Trying. Failing. Figuring things out. Just like me.

## If you could send a 1-minute voice note to a current KCA student, what would you say?

"Hey, I know life at campus can feel like a blur lectures, deadlines, drama, dreams. But trust me, you're in a special moment. The friendships you're making now? They might become your lifeline later. Don't be afraid to go for more. Learn outside the classroom. Say yes to things that scare you. Your potential is bigger than your fears.

And please nurture your network. Not just for future jobs, but for your own well-being. We rise by lifting each other. So show up. Be kind. Take risks. And believe that you're meant for something meaningful. You've got this. I promise."

#### And finally... Sonic?

(Laughs) Yes! That was me. Always buzzing from one thing to the next. Chillzone was my safe space. A little chaotic, a little nerdy but full of heart.

Peris Muthoni Muriuki reminds us that courage doesn't always look like shouting from rooftops. Sometimes, it's a quiet voice saying, "Try again. Build it. Speak up. Be seen." And she's doing exactly that creating space for women, pushing for climate justice and reminding us all to be a little bolder with our dreams.
